

<b>SEQUENCE OF EVENTS REGARDING PROPOSED WILD ASS SANCTUARY AND RIGHTS OF AGARIYAS</b>	
<b>12<sup>th</sup> January 1973</b>	Notification declaring intention of the government to declare 4840 sq.km area of LRK as wild ass sanctuary under Gujarat Wild Bird and Wild animal Protection Act 1963
<b>13<sup>th</sup> January 1978</b>	Notification declaring intention of the government to declare 112.81 sq.km area of LRK as wild ass sanctuary under Wild Life Protection Act 1972
<b>1996</b>	Dhangadhra Prakruti Mandal filed petition in High court, SP C.A. No. 8487 of 1996
<b>11<sup>th</sup> April 1997</b>	In Gujarat HC, Additional Advocate General S.N. Shelat placed the letter dated 19 <sup>th</sup> July 1996 sent by Revenue dept. to the collector, Surendranagar & Banaskantha, mentioning no land within Wild Ass Sanctuary will be granted.
<b>26<sup>th</sup> April 2000</b>	Gujarat high Court disposed off the petition because similar petition was carried before the SC by CERC & SC delivered the judgment – which reported in JT 2000 (2) SCI69pending at supreme court
<b>28<sup>th</sup> April 1997</b>	Notification for establishing office of survey an settlement commissioner and recruitment of staff
<b>25<sup>th</sup> September 1997</b>	Notification declaring 60 days period for claiming of the rights in proposed sanctuary area
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> February 1998</b>	Letter from Add. Collector wild ass to Patan collector requesting to repeal the notification of verification of rights in the proposed sanctuary area.
<b>4<sup>th</sup> July 1998</b>	Letter from secretary Forest and environment recommending The rights of Patan collector withdrawn
<b>Nov 2006</b>	<i>Gangdo Lage Whalo</i> programme informed community that governments intend to declare LRK as wild ass Sanctuary
<b>7<sup>th</sup> Dec .2006</b>	Agariya claimed for their customary rights in LRK
<b>12<sup>th</sup> Dec 2006</b>	Additional collector Wild Ass replied that he received 1776 claims from individual Agariyas and 77 claims of cooperative societies in proposed wild ass sanctuary
<b>January 2007 ....</b>	Additional collector Wild Ass denied the claims, saying that they are not in the stipulated time period.
<b>January 2007....</b>	Agariya replied to the additional collector that they were not aware of the notification. After listening <i>Gangdo Lage Whalo</i> programme
<b>5<sup>th</sup> March 2007</b>	Add. Collector Wild Ass recommended with his letter to Principle Chief Conservator of Forest, about considering Fishing Rights
<b>6<sup>th</sup> March 2007</b>	AHRM wrote to Secretary Forest and environment about traditional rights of Agariyas I proposed sanctuary area. Copy was also sent to Additional Collector Wild Ass, Suredranagar.
<b>23<sup>rd</sup> March 2007</b>	Secretary forest and environment responded.
<b>23<sup>rd</sup> April 2007</b>	AHRM wrote to Chief Minister of the state requesting him to

	intervene in the issue. The same was also sent to Labour Minister.
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> June 2007</b>	RTI application filed by Harinesh Pandya asking about number of Agariyas in LRK
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> June 2007</b>	RTI application filed by Harinesh Pandya asking what is the survey number of LRK
<b>21<sup>st</sup> June 2007</b>	PIO, Industry Commissioner's office replied that there are 48399 Agariyas LRK
<b>27<sup>th</sup> June 2007</b>	A delegation of Agariya met Add. Collector wild ass and represented that they have traditional rights of slat production in LRK and are need to be considered in process of settlements of rights.
<b>20<sup>th</sup> July 2007</b>	PIO District inspector land record – Kutch replied that LRK was never surveyed hence survey number is NIL (0), and comes under Jurisdiction of collector Jamnagar, Kutch, Banaskantha, Surendranagar, Patan and Rajkot collectors
